

### FLOW PLUS DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

# A flowable light cure hybrid resin restorative suitable for Class III, Class IV, and Class V restorations

FLOW PLUS is a flowable light cure hybrid resin restorative suitable for Class III, Class IV, and Class V restorations. Additional functions include: repair of enamel defects, repair of porcelain restorations, minor occlusal build-ups in non-stress bearing areas, pit and fissure sealant, cement for ceramic/composite veneers, incisal abrasions, and core build-ups, This unique composite which incorporates BIS-GMA chemistry along with a proprietary glass filler (approximately 60%) yields a flowable non-slumping restorative material.

FLOW PLUS combination of flowability and direct application system simplifies material placement and minimizes finishing to result in a consistently superior restoration.

### **Directions for Use**

- 1. Isolate and dry preparation.
- 2. Etch enamel and/or dentin for 15 seconds with Medicept's Solo Etch (37.5% phosphoric acid gel\*). Rinse thoroughly and lightly air dry.
- 3. Apply a bonding system such as Bond Plus NT.
- 4. Select the appropriate shade. Dispense a layer of Flow Plus directly onto the preparation along the axial and gingival margins. Use a brushing action to allow the material to flow into the marginal interfaces and recesses of the preparation.
- Incremental layers should be no more than 2 mm. Light cure each increment for a minimum of 40 seconds with a visible light curing unit
- 6. Build contours and ridges to desired shape by flowing the composite into the preparation with a brush-like motion.
- 7. Finish and polish using conventional techniques.
- 8. For a glaze finish, apply one or two drops of Flow Plus, brush over the surface, and cure for 40 seconds.
- CAUTION: Contains phosphoric acid. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and soft tissue. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush immediately with water, get medical attention for eyes. Do not take internally.

# **Shading System**

Flow Plus is available in 16 Vita ccc shades and 5 special shades as follows:

A1, A2, A3, A3.5, A4, B1, B2, B3, B4, C1, C2, C3, C4, D2, D3, D4, Extra Light, G2 (gingival), Universal Opaque, White Opaque, Incisal, **Notes:** 

- 1. Replace syringe cap after each use to prevent the resin from hardening in the syringe.
- 2. Flow Plus dispensing tips are intended for single patient use only.

## **Storage Conditions**

Store FLOW PLUS at room temperature. It has a shelf life of 2 years from date of manufacture.
